Dear Parent/ Carer,

I hope that you and your family are well.

I am writing to you with information about the second opportunity for your daughter to access a Covid-19 vaccination at school, if you would like her to.

Mulberry School for Girls hosted the East London NHS Foundation Trust (ELFT) in October when some students in years 7 – 11 received vaccinations.

ELFT will be visiting us again **on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November** to offer vaccinations to children **aged between 12 and 15**, where both the child and the parent consent to the vaccination.

Trained health professionals will administer the vaccinations.

If your daughter is in year 7 but she is not yet 12 she will not be offered the vaccination.

This form can only be completed by parents/carers. Children cannot give consent themselves for vaccinations administered at school. This service will be available through clinics at a later date with information shared from the NHS.

There have been four online parent information sessions held so far and there have been two opportunities for families to meet face to face with the Tower Hamlets vaccination team at the school.

There will be a further online webinar held this week in Bengali, as this has been requested.
